the Court of Common Pleas, in and for said County, do by
these presents certify, that on the *10th* day of
June in the year A. D. 18*95th*, personally
came before me *Henry Heymann*
a native of *Germany* and heretofore a
subject of the *Empereur of Germany*.

And having been duly sworn, according to law, made his declaration, stating that it
was bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renouncing and
abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereign-
ty whatever, and particularly renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to
the *Emperer of Germany*
whereof he was a former subject.
