I, Frank A. Judson, Prothonotary of the Court of Common Pleas, in and for said County, do by these presents certify that on the 21st day of March in the year A. D. 1901, personally came before me Louis Ingram a native of England and heretofore a subject of the King of England

And having been duly sworn, according to law, made his declaration, stating that it was bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renouncing and adjuring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly renouncing and adjuring all allegiance and fidelity to the King of England whereof he was a former subject.
