


BEAVER COUNTY, SS:



The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

I, Stephen P. Stone Prothonotary of the Court of Common Pleas, in and for said County, do by these presents certify that on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of August in the year A. D. 1884, personally came before me August Robert Brueckner a native of Germany and heretofore a subject of the Emperor of Germany

And having duly been sworn according to law, made his declaration, stating that it was bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to the Emperor of Germany whereof he was a former subject.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed the seal of the said Court, at Beaver, this 7<sup>th</sup> day of August in the year A. D. 1884 and of the Independence of the United States the 108.
