


BEAVER COUNTY, SS:



The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania,
I, *Dan H. Stone*, Prothonotary of
the Court of Common Pleas, in and for said County, do by
these presents certify, that on the *sixteenth* day of
November in the year A. D. *1889*, personally
came before me *Edward Laughlin*
a native of *Scotland* and heretofore a
subject of the *Queen of Great Britain and Ire-*
land and Empress of India,

And having been duly sworn, according to law, made his declaration, stating that it
was bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renouncing and
abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereign-
ty whatever, and particularly renouncing and abjuring ~~all~~ allegiance and fidelity to
the *Queen of Great Britain and Ireland and Empress of India*
whereof he was a former subject.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed the seal
of the said Court, at Beaver, this *sixteenth* day of *November* in the
year A. D. *1889*, and of the Independence of the United States the *114*.
