


Beaver County ss:



The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania,

I, O. A. Small Prothonotary of the Court of Common Pleas, in and for said county, do by these presents certify, that on the 5th day of September in the year A. D. 1878 personally came before me, William Louw a native of England and heretofore a subject of the Queen of Great Britain Ireland & Empress of India.

And having duly been sworn according to law, made his declaration, stating that it was bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States. and renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity, to the Queen of Great Britain Ireland & Empress of India whereof he was a former subject.
