whence he migrated in the year 1870 and has selected the United States of America as the
place of his intended settlement; and that it is a bona fide his intention to become a citizen
thereof, and to absolutely renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince,
Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly to the Queen of Great
Britain & Ireland and empress of India
of whom he is now a subject
