I, Saml H. Stone Prothonotary of  
the Court of Common Pleas, in and for said County, do by  
these presents certify, that on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of  
October in the year A. D. 1887, personally  
came before me Robert McLaughlin  
a native of Ireland and heretofore a  
subject of the Queen of Great Britain &  
Ireland & Empress of India.

And having been duly sworn, according to law, made his declaration, stating that it  
was bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renouncing and  
abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereign-  
ty whtsoever, and, particularly renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to  
the Queen of Great Britain & Ireland & Empress of India,  
whereof he was a former subject.

the said Court, at Beaver, this 26<sup>th</sup> day of October in the year  
A. D. 1887, and of the Independence of the United States the 11<sup>th</sup>.
