

whence he migrated in the year 1837, and has selected the United States of America as the  
place of his intended settlement; and that it is a bona fide his intention to become a citizen thereof,  
and to absolutely renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State  
or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly to the Queen of England and Ireland  
and Empress of India  
of whom he is now a subject.
