I, George N. Mackall Prothonotary of the Court of Common Pleas, in and for said County, do by these presents certify that on the 12th day of July in the year A. D. 1897, personally came before me Andrew Mannon a native of Ireland and heretofore a subject of the Queen of Great Britain & Ireland

And having been duly sworn, according to law, made his declaration, stating that it was bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renouncing and adjuring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly renouncing and adjuring all allegiance and fidelity to the Queen of Great Britain & Ireland whereof he was a former subject.
