Be it Remembered, That on this 30th day of August, in the year eighteen hundred and Eighty
Ernest Mayer a native of England
appears in the Clerk's Office, and makes the following report to the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Allegany county:

That he arrived in the United States of America, from England
the place of his nativity, in the year 1879, that he is about 22 years of age, and that he intends to settle in Allegany county, Maryland. At the same time said Ernest Mayer makes oath in open Court on the Holy Evangelly of the Almighty God, that it is *bona fide* his intention to become a citizen of the United States of America, and that he doth renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign Prince, Potentate or State Sovereignty whatsoever, and particularly to the Queen of Great Britain to whom he was formerly subject.
