

I, George W. Mackall Prothonotary of
the Court of ~~Common Pleas~~ Common Pleas, in and for said County, do by
these presents certify, that on the 21st day of
September in the year A. D. 1892, personally
came before me George Michelette
a native of Italy and heretofore a
subject of the King of Italy

And having been duly sworn, according to law, made his declaration, stating that it
was bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renouncing and
abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereign-
ty whatever, and particularly renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to
the King of Italy
whereof he was a former subject.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed the seal
of the said Court, at Beaver, this 21st day of Sept. in the
year A. D. 1892, and of the Independence of the United States the 116.
