Be it Remembered, That on the 10 day of June  
A. D. 1871 Personally appeared before me, the Prothonotary of the  
Court of Common Pleas of Beaver County, Frederick Miller  
and on his solemn oath according to  
law, doth depose and say, that he was born in the year 1840  
in the Kingdom of Bavaria

whence he migrated in the year 1868 and has selected the United States of America  
as the place of his intended settlement; and that it is bona fide his intention to become a  
Citizen thereof; and to absolutely renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign  
Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly to the Emperor  
of Germany  
of whom he is now a Subject
