


THE STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA,

W. Rogers

and on his solemn oath, according to law, doth depose and say
that he was born in the year 1858 in the City of Man-

chester England

whence he migrated in the year 1862 and has selected the United States of America as the
place of his intended settlement; and that it is a bona fide his intention to become a citizen
thereof, and to absolutely renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince,
Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly to the Queen of Great

Britain

of whom he is now a subject
