I, **David K. McGunnegle**, Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions, of Allegheny County, in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, do hereby certify, that on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of October A. D., one thousand eight hundred and eighty eighty before me, the Clerk of said Court, John Patrick Bush a native of Ireland came and declared his intention, bona fide, of becoming a citizen of the United States, and also his intention to renounce and abjure forever all allegiance to any foreign prince, potentate, state or sovereignty whatever, and particularly to renounce and abjure forever all allegiance and fidelity to the Queen of Great Britain whereof he was heretofore a subject.
