I, David K. McGunnegle, Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions, of Allegheny County, in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, do hereby certify, that on the 19th day of June A. D., one thousand eight hundred and ninety- before me, the Clerk of said Court, Gustav Schwarz a native of Germany came and declared his intention, bona fide, of becoming a citizen of the United States, and also his intention to renounce and abjure forever all allegiance to any foreign prince, potentate, state or sovereignty whatever, and particularly to renounce and abjure forever all allegiance and fidelity to the Emperor of Germany whereof he was heretofore a subject.
