the Court of Common Pleas, in and for said County, do by
these presents certify, that on the *Third* day of
January in the year, A. D. 18*93*, personally
came before me *John T. Septon*,
a native of *England* and heretofore a
subject of the *Queen of England*.

And having been duly sworn, according to law, made his declaration, stating that it
was bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renouncing and
abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty
whatever, and particularly renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to
the *Queen of England*,
whereof he was a former subject.
