


BEAVER COUNTY, SS:

I, Stephen P. Stone — Prothonotary of
the Court of Common Pleas, in and for said County, do
by these presents certify that on the fifth day
September in the year A. D. 1884, personally
came before me Theodore Stuka
a native of Germany — and heretofore a
subject of the Emperor of Germany —

And having duly been sworn according to law, made his declaration, stating that it was
bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renouncing and
abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty
whatever, and particularly renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to the
Emperor of Germany — — — — —
— — — — — whereof he was a former subject.

in the year A. D. 1884 and of the Independence of the United States the 109.
