BE IT REMEMBERED, That on the 23rd day of August, A. D., one thousand eight hundred and Eighty Six, personally appeared before me at the Prothonotary's Office in and for the County of Mifflin, Emil Trautvetter, who upon his solemn oath doth depose and say that he was born in Steinbach Saxony Germany, sailed from Antwerp on the 27th day of August 1880 and landed in Philadelphia on the 13th day of September 1880 when he has since resided

and that Pennsylvania is now his place of residence. And now on his solemn oath doth declare and say, that it is bona fide his intention to become a citizen of the United States of America; and that he doth absolutely and entirely renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatsoever, and particularly to William Emperor of Germany his

heirs and successors forever; and that he doth hereby relinquish all order of nobility, to which he is now, or may hereafter be entitled to.
