certify, that on the Thirtieth day of January

Germany and declared his intention, bona fide, of becoming a Citizen of the United States, and also his intention to renounce and abjure forever all allegiance to any foreign prince, potentate, state or sovereignty, whatever, and particularly to renounce and abjure forever all allegiance and fidelity to the

Emperor of Germany whereof he is before a subject.

In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed the seal of the said Court at the City of Pittsburgh, this 30th day of Jan'y A. D. 1893, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and seventeenth.
