the Court of Common Pleas, in and for said County, do by
these presents certify, that on the Twenty-ninth day of
January in the year A. D. 1889, personally
came before me Joseph Walker
a native of England and heretofore a
subject of the Queen of Great Britain and
Ireland & Empress of India

And having been duly sworn, according to law, made his declaration, stating that it
was bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renouncing and
abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereign-
ty whatever, and particularly renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to
the Queen of Great Britain & Ireland & Empress of India
whereof he was a former subject.

year A. D. 1889, and of the Independence of the United States the 113th.
