Be it Remembered, That on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of May,  
A. D. 1854 Personally appeared before me, the Prothonotary of the  
Court of Common Pleas of Beaver County, Jacob  
Boier and on his solemn oath according to  
law, doth depose and say, that he was born in the year 1823  
in the Kingdom of Boier, in Germany,

whence he migrated in the year 1857 and has selected the **United States of America**  
as the place of his intended settlement; and that it is **bona fide** his intention to become a  
**Citizen** thereof, and to absolutely renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign  
Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly to the King of  
Boier in Germany  
of whom he is now a subject
