*King of Prussia* — came before me, and having

been duly sworn according to law, made his declaration stating that it was *bona fide* his inten-

tion to become a citizen of the United States, and renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and

fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state or sovereignty

whatever, and particularly renouncing and abjuring all allegiance

and fidelity to the *King of Prussia*

whereof he was a former subject.
