Be it Remembered, That on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of March  
A. D. 1852 Personally appeared before me, the Prothonotary of the  
Court of Common Pleas of Beaver County, William Wilson  
and on his solemn oath according to  
law, doth depose and say, that he was born in the year 1812  
in ~~the~~ Scotland,

whence he migrated in the year 1829 and has selected the **United States of America**  
as the place of his intended settlement; and that it is **bona fide** his intention to become a  
**Citizen** thereof, and to absolutely renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign  
Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly to the Queen of  
England  
of whom he is now a Subject
