And having been duly sworn, according to law, made his declaration, stating that it was
bona fied his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renouncing and ad-
juring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty
whatever, and particularly renouncing and adjuring all allegiance and fidelity to
the Empire of Germany
whereof he was a former subject.
