


BEAVER COUNTY, SS:

I, Stephen P. Stone Prothonotary of the Court of Common Pleas, in and for said County, do by these presents certify that on the 14th day

February in the year A. D. 1884, personally came before me Wm. Alexander Blair a native of Ireland and heretofore a subject of the Queen of England and Ireland and Empress of India

And having duly been sworn according to law, made his declaration, stating that it was bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to the Queen of England and Ireland and Empress of India whereof he was a former subject.
