

The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

I, Daniel D. Boyde, Deputy Prothonotary of the Court of Common Pleas, in and for said County, do by these presents certify that on the Twenty Ninth day of May in the year A. D. 1907, personally came before me Robert Armour a native of Ireland and heretofore a subject of the King of Great Britain and Ireland.

And having been duly sworn, according to law, made his declaration, stating that it was bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renouncing and adjuring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly renouncing and adjuring all allegiance and fidelity to the King of Great Britain and Ireland whereof he was a former subject.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed the seal of the said Court at Beaver, this Twenty Ninth day of May in the year A. D. 1907, and of the independence of the United States the 126
