law, doth depose and say, that he was born in the year 1812
in the County of Cork, Ireland in

the Kingdom of Great Britain
whence he migrated in the year 1850 and has selected the **United States of America**
as the place of his intended settlement; and that it is bona fide his intention to become a
Citizen thereof, and to absolutely renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign
Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly to the Queen
of Great Britain, Ireland, &c.
of whom he is now a subject
