presents certify that on the 3rd day of
January in the year A. D. 1896, personally
came before me Louis Cerny
a native of Bohemia and heretofore a
subject of the Emperor of Austria.

And having been duly sworn, according to law, made his declaration, stating that it was
bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renouncing and ad-
vowing all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty
whatever, and particularly renouncing and adjuring all allegiance and fidelity to
Emperor of Austria.

Proof he was a former subject.
