

Clerk's Office, Ohio County Court, *May 21<sup>st</sup>* 1853

*Frederick Dauber* a native of *Germany*

THIS DAY came before me, JOHN M'COLLOCH, Clerk of the County Court of Ohio County aforesaid, in the state of Virginia, in my office, and declared as follows, viz. I was born

in *Byrne* - - - - - on the *20<sup>th</sup>* day of *March 1882*

I am a *Butcher* - - - - - by profession or occupation; I sailed from *Havre* - - - - - on the *26<sup>th</sup>* day of *March 1852* and

landed at the port of *New York* on the *21<sup>st</sup>* day of *April 1852*

I came to *Wheeling direct* where I have lived *ever since*

I declare it to be my bonafide intention to become a citizen of the United States, and to renounce forever, all allegiaunce and fidelity to every Foreign Prince and Potentate, State and Sovereignty whatever, and particularly to *The King of Byrne*
