Britain &c

And having been duly sworn, according to law, made his declaration, stating that it
was bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renouncing and
abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereign-
ty whgtever, and particularly renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to
the Queen of England &c
whereof he was a former subject.
