And having been duly sworn, according to law, made his declaration, stating that it was  
bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renouncing and ad-  
juring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty  
whatever, and particularly renouncing and adjuring all allegiance and fidelity to the  
*King of Italy*  
whereof he was a former subject.
