having been duly sworn according to law, made his declaration, stating
that it was bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States,

and renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to any Foreign prince, potentate, State or Sovereignty
whatevex, and particularly renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to the Empire
of the French whereof he was a former subject.

Beaver, this 3^d day of November in the year A. D. 1856 and of the
