D. one thousand eight hundred and fifty five before the Clerk of the said Court, Joseph S. Romaly a native of Ireland came and declared his intention, *bona fide*, of becoming a citizen of the United States, and also his intention to renounce and forever abjure all allegiance to any foreign prince or potentate, particularly to renounce and abjure forever all allegiance and fidelity to the Government of Great Britain & Ireland whereof he was heretofore a subject.
