

and heretofore a subject of the *Queen of Great Britain* And
having been duly sworn according to law, made his declaration, stating
that it was bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States,
renouncing all allegiances and fidelity to any Foreign prince, potentate, State, or Sovereignty
whosoever, and particularly renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to the *Queen of*
Great Britain *Island* whereof he was a former subject.
