I, Dan H. Stone Prothonotary of
the Court of Common Pleas, in and for said County, do by
these presents certify, that on the 28th day of
March in the year A. D. 1888, personally
came before me John Dripps
a native of Ireland and heretofore a
subject of the Queen of Great Britain & Ireland
and Empress of India.

And having been duly sworn, according to law, make his declaration, stating that it
was bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renouncing and
abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereign-
ty whatever, and particularly renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to
the Queen of Great Britain and Ireland and Empress of India
whereof he was a former subject.
