Be it Remembered, That on this 14th day of Dec in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety Nine personally appeared before me, the Prothonotary of the Court of Common Pleas No. 1, within the County and State aforesaid and filed his Declaration of Intention, to become a citizen of the United States, agreeably to the provisions of the Acts of Congress of the United States in such cases made and provided, as follows:

Pankraz Finzel who made oath that he is a native of Germany, aged about 32 years; that he emigrated from Breiten in 1897; and arrived in the United States, to wit, at Baltimore on the 28th day of May in 1897; by trade a Farmer, that he now resides within, and under the jurisdiction and government of the United States, to wit: at Sewickley Township, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and that it is bona fide his intention to become a CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, and to renounce and abjure forever all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly to Emperor of Germany whereof he was heretofore a subject.
