and having been duly sworn according to law, made his declaration, stating, that it was
bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renouncing and
abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state or sovereignty
whichever, and particularly renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to the
King of France whereof he was a former subject.
