I, Daniel D. Boyde Deputy Prothonotary of
the Court of Common Pleas, in and for said County, do by these
presents certify that on the 24th day of
January in the year A. D. 1905, personally
came before me Abraham Freed
a native of Russia - Poland and heretofore a
subject of the Czar of Russia.

And having been duly sworn, according to law, made his declaration, stating that it was
bona fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renouncing and ad-
juring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty
whatever, and particularly renouncing and adjuring all allegiance and fidelity to the
Czar of Russia
whereof he was a former subject.
