*3* day of *Oct* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty *Eight*

a native of *England* and heretofore a subject of the *Queen of Great Britain* came before me, and

having been duly sworn according to law, made his declaration, stating that it was *bona fide* his intention to become a citizen of the United States, and renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state or sovereignty whatever, and

particularly renouncing and abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to the *Queen of Great Britain* whereof he was a
